Gospel – Matthew 5:1-6


¹ Now when Jesus saw the crowds, He went up on a mountain side and sat down. His disciples came to Him, ² and He began to teach them. He said: ³ "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ⁴ Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. ⁵ Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. ⁶ Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."

New Testament Lesson – 1 Corinthians 2:9-16

⁹ However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived" – the things God has prepared for those who love Him – ¹⁰ these are the things God has revealed to us by His Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. ¹¹ For who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us. ¹³ This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words. ¹⁴ The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit. ¹⁵ The person with the Spirit makes judgments, ¹⁶ for, "Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

Old Testament Lesson - Psalm 42

¹ As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for You, my God. ² My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God? ³ My tears have been my food day and night, while people say to me all day long, "Where is your God?" 4 These things I remember as I pour out my soul: how I used to go to the house of God under the protection of the Mighty One with shouts of joy and praise among the festive throng. ⁵ Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise Him, my Savior and my God. ⁶ My soul is downcast within me; therefore I will remember You from the land of the Jordan, the heights of Hermon – from Mount Mizar. 7 Deep calls to deep in the roar of Your waterfalls; all Your waves and breakers have swept over me. 8 By day the LORD directs His love, at night His song is with me – a prayer to the God of my life. ⁹ I say to God my Rock, "Why have You forgotten me? Why must I go about mourning, oppressed by the enemy?" ¹⁰ My bones suffer mortal agony as my foes taunt me, saying to me all day long, "Where is your God?" ¹¹ Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise Him, my Savior and my God.
